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

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The first bottle from our TOP 20 rum bottles list is one of the most famous rum bottles by an Italian brand called Velier. The bottle of rum comes from the Caroni distillery in Trinidad, where its distillation began in 2000. It was bottled in 2017 after 17 years of aging, with an ABV of 68.4%. Only 242 bottles were produced.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from March 2018, when the price was around 588 €. Over the last year, the cost of this bottle has increased by 227.8% - from 2 605 € to the current market value, which is 8 540 €.

It can currently be purchased in a French e-store for 9 680 €, which is roughly 13% more than the current market value. Unfortunately, there is no online auction at this time. The last sale of this bottle at an online auction was recorded in November 2022 and was auctioned for 7 401 €.

The next bottle that made it to our list is another bottle by Velier, which also comes from Trinidad, from the Caroni distillery, where its distillation began in 2000. The bottle was aging until 2015, so it is a fifteen-year-old rum with an ABV of 68.4%.

The earliest data we have on this bottle is from February 2017, when the price was around 246 €. The current market value is 7 003 €, which is 156.9% more than a year ago when its price was 2726 €.

The bottle is currently not available for purchase in any e-store or online auction. This year, the bottle appeared in German e-stores, where it was sold for $4500 \in$. Although this bottle did not appear in online auctions this year, it was last auctioned in December 2022 for $7003 \in$.



Bielle





This bottle was produced by Bielle; the year of distillation is 2004, and the year of bottling is 2014, so it is a ten-year-old rum originating from Maria Galante.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from September 2020, when the price was around 214 €. The current market value is 750 €, which is 258.8% more than the price a year ago, which was 209 €.

The bottle can currently be purchased in an Italian e-store for 750 \in . Unfortunately, the online auction is now not running. This bottle was last auctioned in March 2022 for 224 \in .





This rum merges Bielle and Velier, and only 59 bottles were produced. The year of distillation of this rum is 2001, and the year of bottling is 2015, so it is a fourteen-year-old rum originating from Maria Galante, with an ABV of 54.6%.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from September 2020, when the price was around 317 €. The current market value is 835 €, which is 135.9% more than a year ago when the price was set at 354 €.

The bottle can currently be bought on French eBay for 835 €. Unfortunately, the online auction is not presently running, nor do we have any records of past online auctions.

This is an A.H. Riise bottle, and it comes from the USA. Only 6 000 bottles were produced at an ABV of 42%.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from August 2020, when the price was around 208 €. The current market value is 748 €, which is 84.2% more than a year ago when the price was 406 €.

The bottle can currently be bought in a Czech e-store for $1027 \in$, which is 37% more than the current market value. It can also be bought in a German e-store for 998 \in , which is 33% more than the current market value. Unfortunately, the online auction is currently unavailable for purchase. The bottle was last auctioned on November 2022 for 576 \in .





<u>Here is another bottle by A.H.Riise, also from the USA</u>; 10 000 bottles were produced at 45% ABV.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from August 2020, when the price was around 96 €. The current market value is 191 €, which is 64.7% more than a year ago when the price was 116 €.

It can currently be purchased at several e-stores, including Czech e-stores, where the price ranges from 200 € to 230 €. It can also be bought in a Switzerland e-store for 159 € and on French eBay for 152 €. Unfortunately, we did not find the bottle at any live auctions. The last time the bottle was auctioned was in July 2022 for 125 €.



Havana Club






And now, let's take a look at the Havana Club bottles. <u>This one came from Cuba</u> and was bottled at 45% ABV.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from October 2015, when the price was around 61 €. The current market value is 154 €, which is 75% more than a year ago, i.e., 88 €.

Currently, this bottle can be bought in a Danish e-store for $214 \in$, which is 39% more than the current market value. Unfortunately, no online auction is currently running. The last time this bottle of rum was auctioned was in August 2022 for 95 \in .





You are looking at another bottle produced by Havana Club; this rum also comes from Cuba and was bottled in 2016 into only 2 500 bottles.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from June 2018, when the price was around 630 €. The current market value is 842 €, which is 59.2% more than its price a year ago, which was 511 €.

The good news is that it can currently be bought in a Swiss e-store for 1 196 €, which is 42% more than the current market value. And in a Danish e-store for 1 139 €, which is 35% more than the current market value. A live auction is currently underway and ends on January 23, 2023. This bottle was last auctioned in January 2023 for 682 €.



Bristol Clasic Rum





And now, let's move on to the exciting bottles produced by the Bristol Classic Rum brand; <u>this one began its distillation in 1986</u> at the West Indies Distillery in Barbados and was bottled in 2012.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from May 2017, when the cost was around 140 €. The current market value is 477 €, which is 68.6% more than the price a year ago, i.e., 283 €.

Rum can currently be bought on German eBay for $549 \in$, which is 15% more than the current market value. It can also be bought in a German e-store for $495 \in$, which is only 4% more than the current market value. Unfortunately, no online auction is currently running. The bottle was last auctioned in September 2022 for $411 \in$.






Once again, look at another <u>Bristol Classis Rum, this time from the Caroni</u> <u>distillery in Trinidad</u>. The rum bottle was distilled in 1997 and bottled in 2016 at 61.5% ABV.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from September 2018, when the price was around 100 €. The current market value is $379 \in$, which is 57.9% more than a year ago when the price was 240 €.

This bottle of rum can be bought in an Italian e-store for 541 \in , which is 43% more than the current market value. And in a German e-store for 399 \in , which is only 5% more than the current market value. No online auction is currently taking place, but the last time rum was auctioned was in December 2022 for 356 \in .









And now, let's look at the bottles from the Silver Seal brand; <u>this one began its</u> <u>distillation in 1997 at the Caroni distillery</u> in Trinidad. It was bottled in 2017 at an ABV of 64.8%. This rum comes from a limited edition of only 212 bottles.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from October 2018, when the price was around 370 €. The current market value is 1 834 €, which is 119.2% more than a year ago when the price was 837 €.

You can currently buy a bottle in an Italian e-store for 2 000 \in , which is only 9% more than the current market value. Unfortunately, there is no live auction at the moment. This bottle of rum was last auctioned in October 2022 for 1 667 \in .





The second bottle produced by Silver Seal is this 20-year-old rum, distilled in 1974 and bottled in 2003. The rum comes from the Demerara distillery in Guyana. The production is limited to 470 bottles.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from November 2016, when the price was around 980 €. The current market value is 3 460 €, which is 79% more than a year ago, i.e., 1 933 €.

Currently, this bottle of rum can be bought in a German e-store for 3 990 €, which is about 14% more than the current market value.; and in an Italian e-store for 3 000 €, which is about 13% less than the current market value. There is no online auction in the running, but this bottle of rum was last sold in October 2021 for 1 300 €.



Savanna





Now let's look at two interesting bottles by a brand called Savanna. <u>The first one</u> is this five-year-old rum, which year of distillation is 2015. The rum comes from the island of Réunion and was bottled in 2020. Like all the bottles on this list, this rum is a limited edition and bottled into just 840 bottles.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from February 2021, when the price was around 105 €. The current market value is $329 \in$, which is 186.1% more than a year ago when its price was 115 €.

At the moment, this rum can be bought on German eBay for its current market value, i.e., 329 euros. Unfortunately, there are currently no online auctions; the bottle was last auctioned on March 2022 for 151 €.







Another bottle from the Savanna brand is this 10-year-old rum from Reunion Island, which began distillation in 2006 and was bottled in 2017 at an ABV of 50.8% to only 721 bottles.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from February 2020, when the price was around 44 €. The current market value is 294 €, up 108.5% from €141 a year ago.

You won't find this rum in any e-stores now, and there is no online auction going on. The last time a bottle was auctioned was in October 2022 for 276 €.







And for now, let's move on to the La Favorite brand and two interesting bottles. This is the first one and the year of distillation is 2016; it comes from Martinique and was bottled in 2020. Only 1 000 bottles of this four-year-old rum were produced at an ABV of 50.7%.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from November 2020, when the price was around 110 €. The current market value is 230 €, which is 101.8% more than a year ago when the price was $114 \in$.

You can buy this bottle of rum in a French e-store for $300 \in$, which is about 30% more than the current market value. Unfortunately, no online auction is currently running. The bottle was last auctioned in December 2022 for 160 \in .






<u>The second and last bottle of La Favorite rum was distilled in 1988</u>; it comes from Martinique, and only 6 000 bottles were produced with an ABV of 40%.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from July 2017, when the price was around 195 €. The current market value is 1 355 €, which is 62.5% more than a year ago when the price was 834 €.

A bottle can be bought in a French e-store for 2 000 \in , which is about 48% more than the current market value. Unfortunately, no online auction is running now. The last sale of this bottle at an online auction was recorded in August 2022 for 710 \in .



Transcontinental Rum Line





This 12-year-old rum comes from the Diamond Distillery in Guyana. The year of distillation is 2003, and the year of bottling is 2016, when the rum was bottled into only 398 bottles at an ABV of 57%.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from March 2017, when the price was around 89 €. The current market value is 305 €, which is 54% more than a year ago, i.e., 198 €.

You can buy the bottle in an Italian e-store for $305 \in$, which is also the current market value. Unfortunately, any online auction is currently not running—the last time this bottle of rum was auctioned was in April 2022 for $84 \in$ and then for $119 \in$.





The second and last bottle from the Transcontinental Rum Line on our list is this rum that comes from Haiti and was bottled in 2018 into only 220 bottles. It is a 12-year-old rum with an ABV of 63.1%

Our earliest data on this bottle is from October 2018, when the price was around 94 €. The current market value is 161 €, which is 37.6% more than a year ago when the price was 117 €.

This rum can be bought in an Italian e-store for 190 €, which is about 18% more than the current market value. You can also buy it in an Austrian e-store for 115 €, which is about 18% less than the current market value. Unfortunately, we didn't record any live auctions at the moment. The bottle was last auctioned in February 2020 for 77 €.



Neisson





Neisson is the latest brand that made it to our TOP 20 rum list. <u>This bottle is from</u> the Tatanka limited edition and was bottled at an ABV of 50%.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from December 2020, when the price was around 130 €. The current market value is $302 \in$, which is 134.1% more than a year ago when the price was $129 \in$.

In an Italian e-store, this bottle can be bought for 201 €, which is about 34% less than the current market value. Unfortunately, there is no online auction at the moment. Rum was last auctioned in October 2022 for 402 €.






And this is the last bottle on this list. <u>Again, it is a rum from the limited edition</u> <u>of Tatanka and comes from Martinique</u>.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from August 2017, when the price was around 95 €. The current market value is $350 \in$, which is 101.2% more than a year ago when the price was $174 \in$.

You can buy the bottle on Italian eBay for $350 \in$, which is also its current market value. Unfortunately, no online auction is running now. The bottle was last auctioned in November 2021 for $176 \in$.








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
